

SHARE OF AFT IN DEVELOPMENT FINANCE AND FIXED CAPITAL FORMATION (%)





TRADE COSTS (ad-valorem, %)



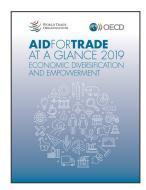
