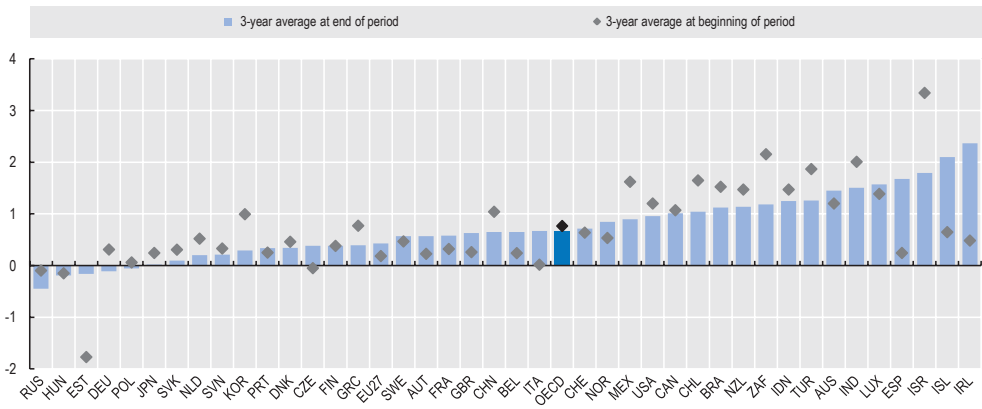

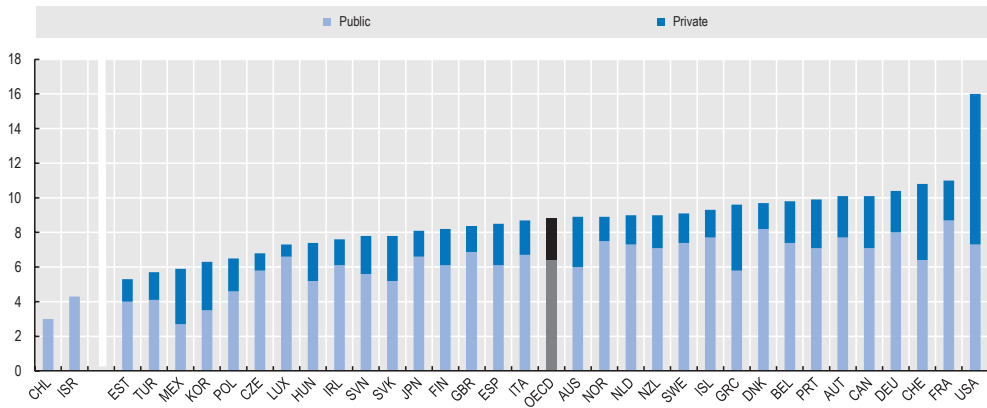

Average annual growth in percentage



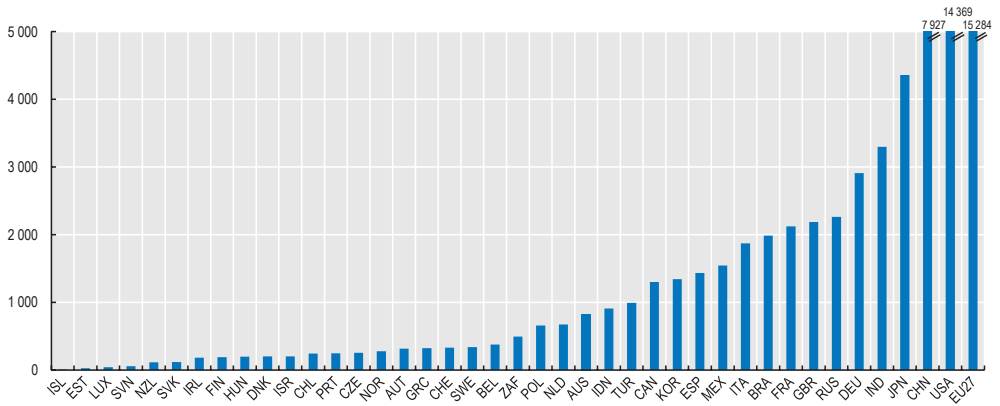
Public and private expenditure on health

As a percentage of GDP, 2007 or latest available year



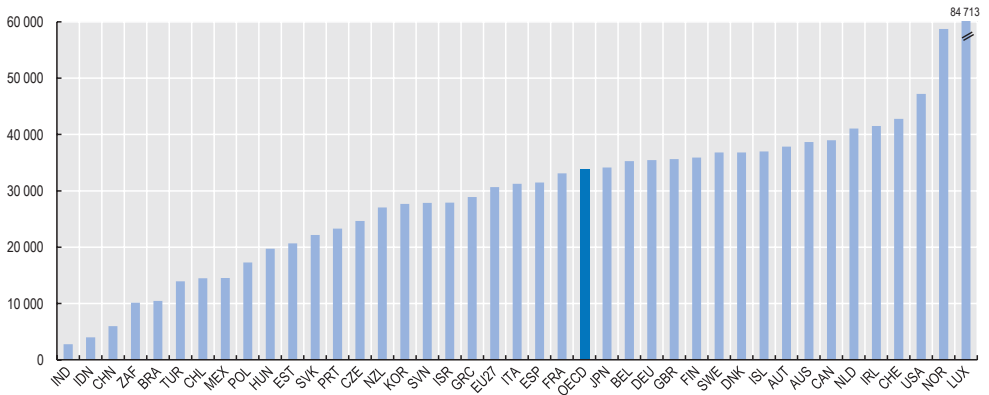
Gross domestic product

Billion US dollars, current prices and PPPs, 2008



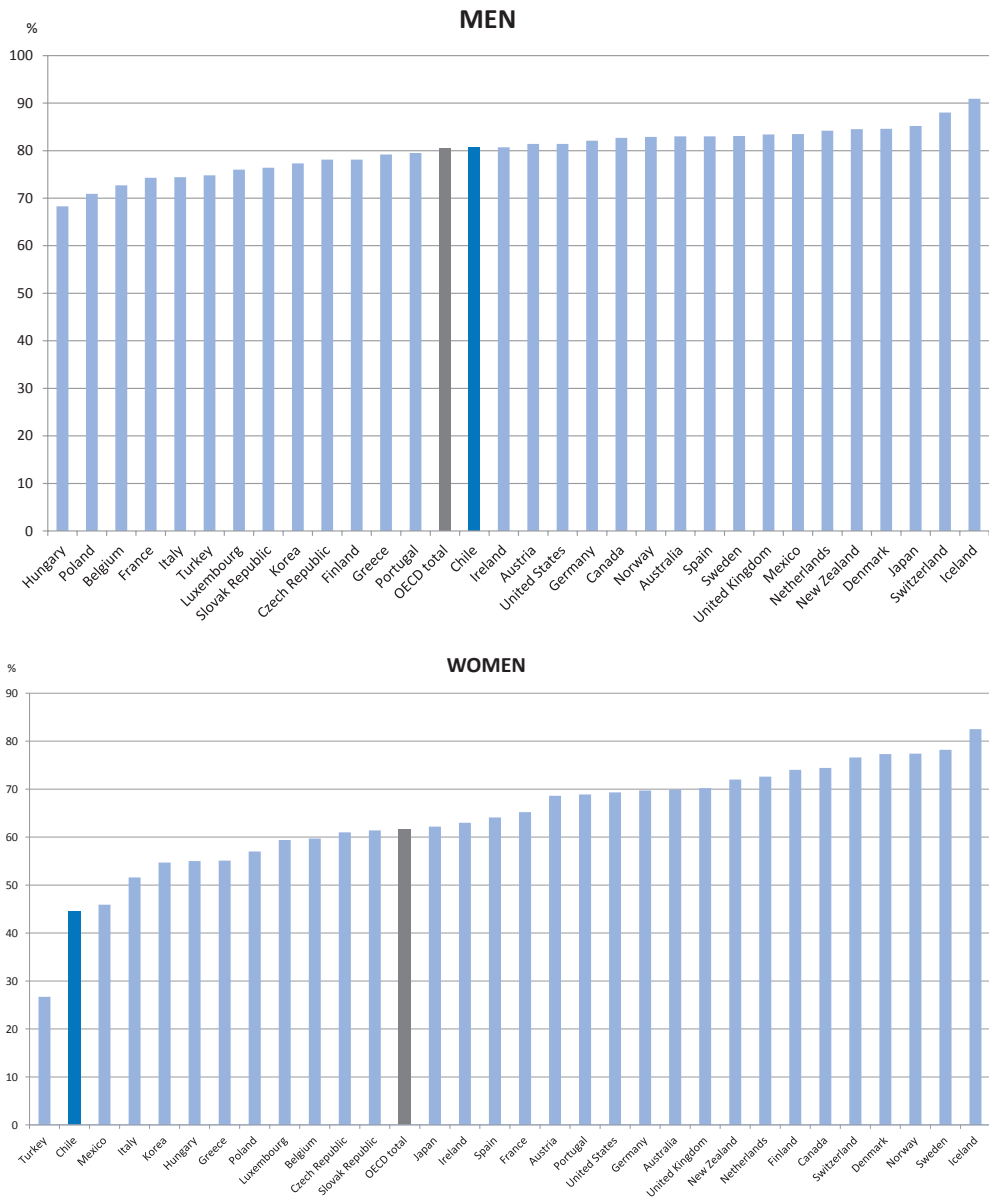
GDP per capita

Labour force participation rates

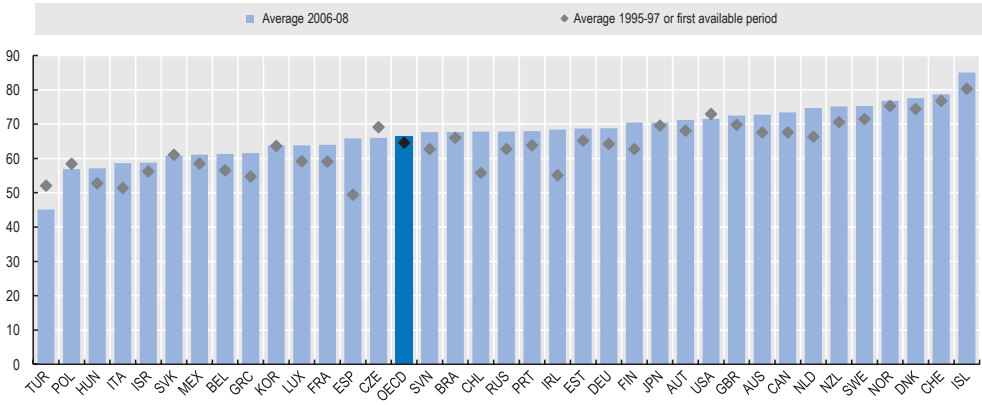
15-64 years, 2008

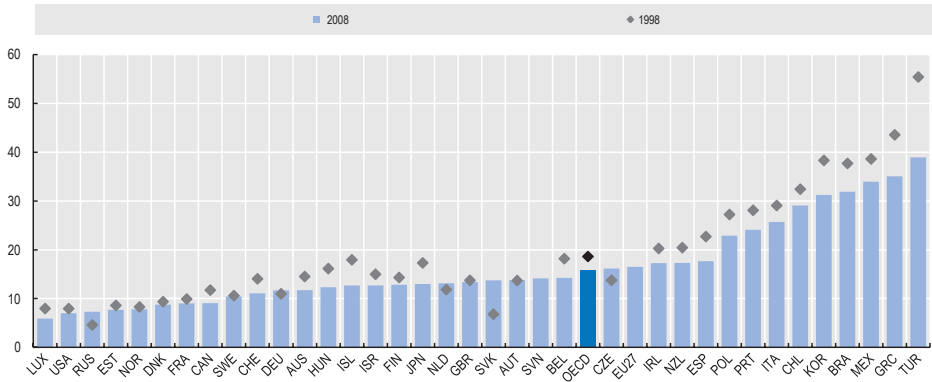

Share of persons of working age in employment



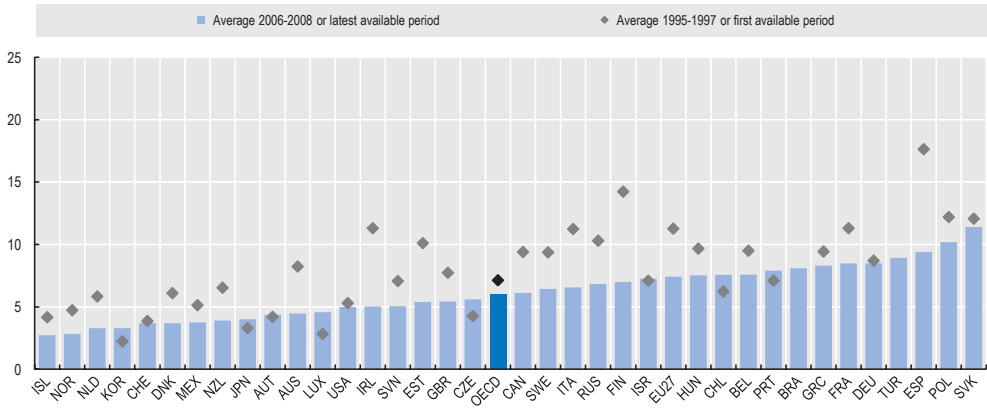
Self-employment rates: total

As a percentage of total employment



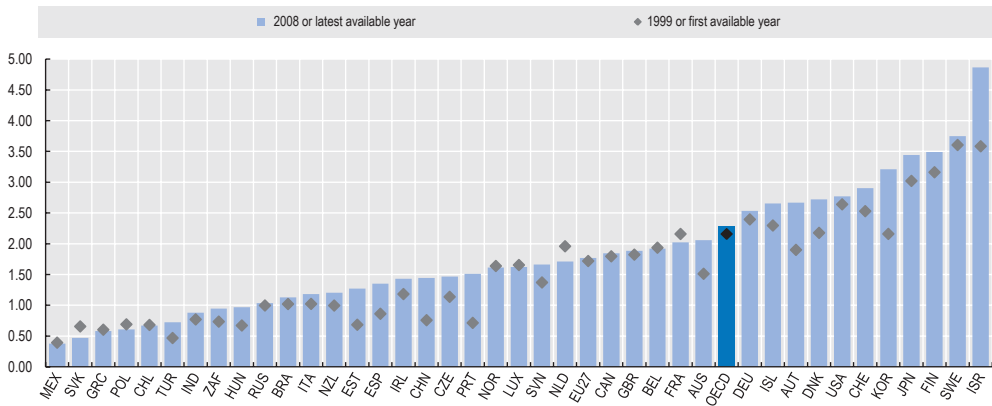
Unemployment rates: total

As a percentage of labour force



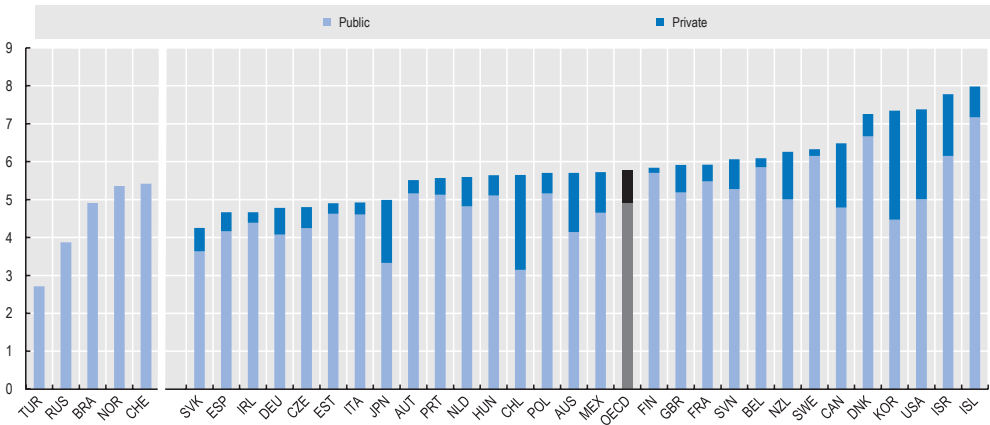
Gross domestic expenditure on R&D

As a percentage of GDP



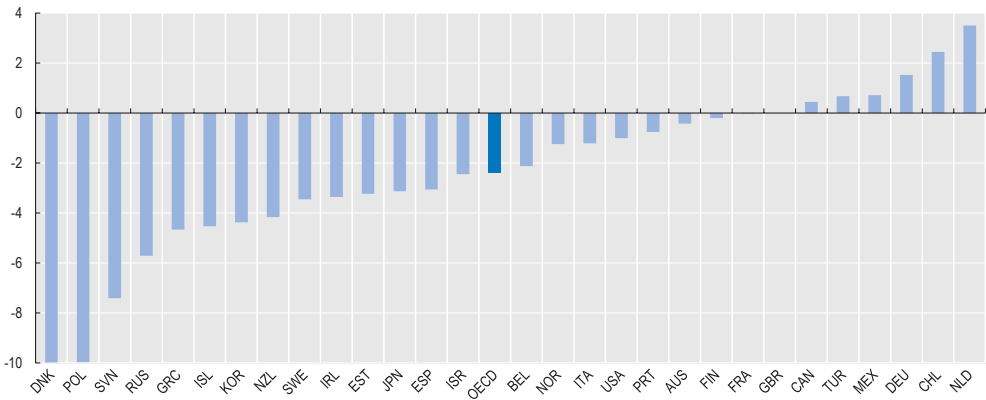
Public and private expenditure on education for all levels of education

As a percentage of GDP, 2006



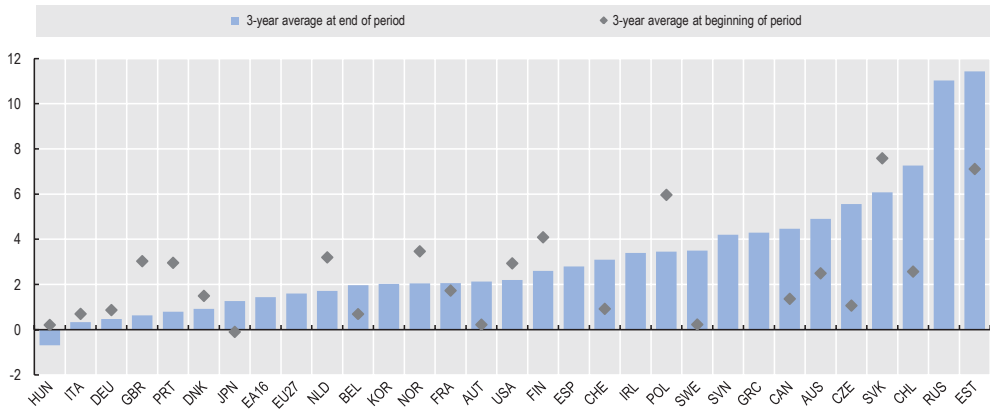
Fish landings in domestic and foreign ports

Average annual growth in percentage, 1997-2007 or latest available period



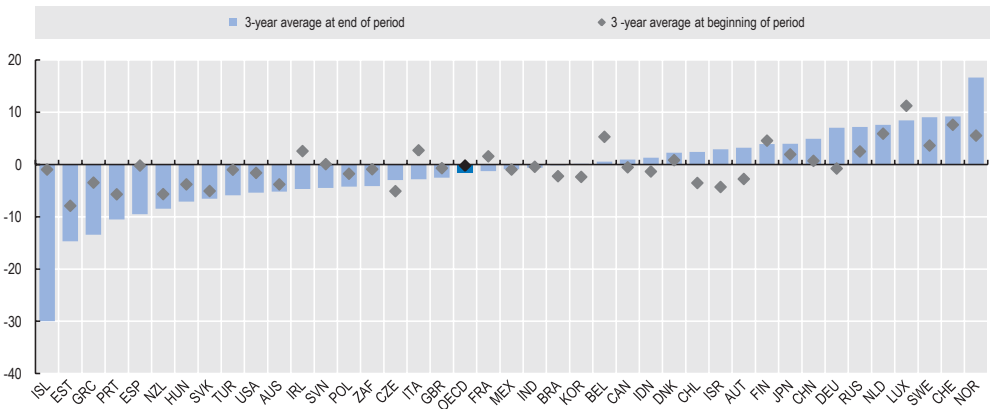
Household disposable income

Average annual growth in percentage



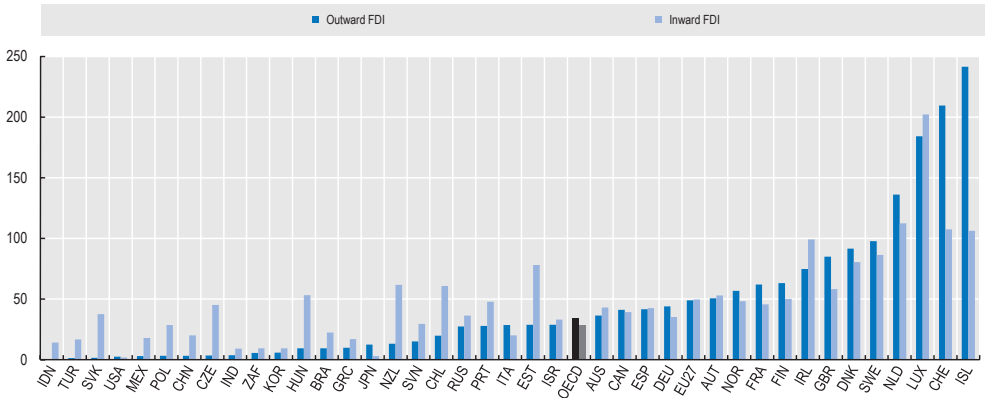
Current account balance

As a percentage of GDP (1995–2008)



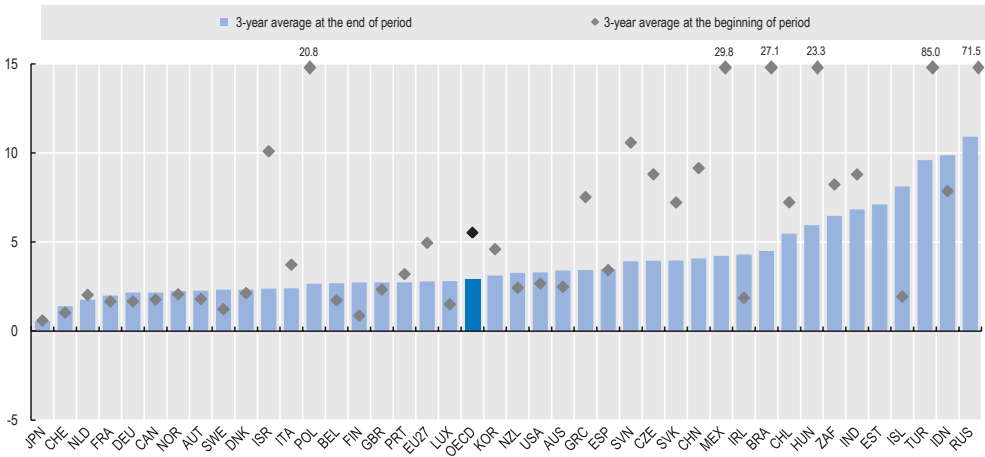
FDI stocks

As a percentage of GDP, 2007 or latest available year



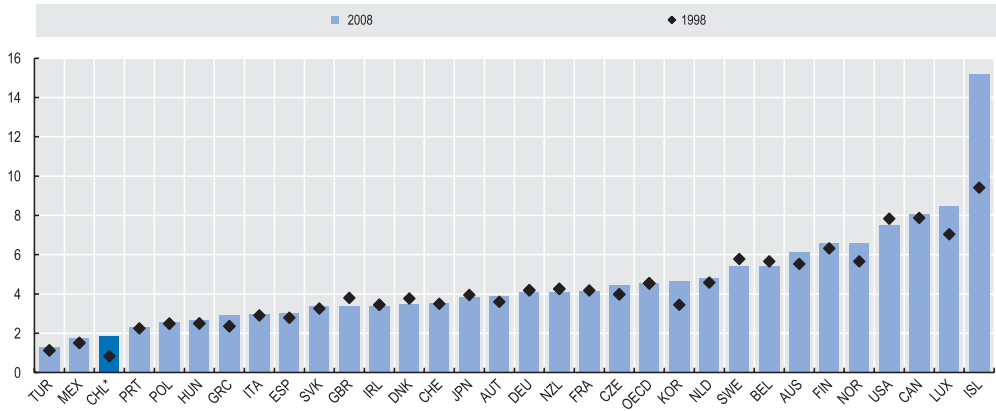

Total primary energy supply per capita¹

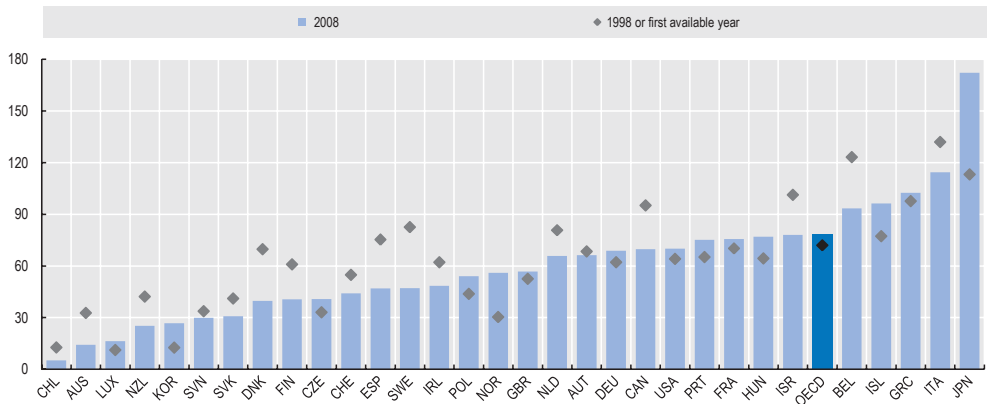
Tonnes of oil equivalent (toe) per capita
