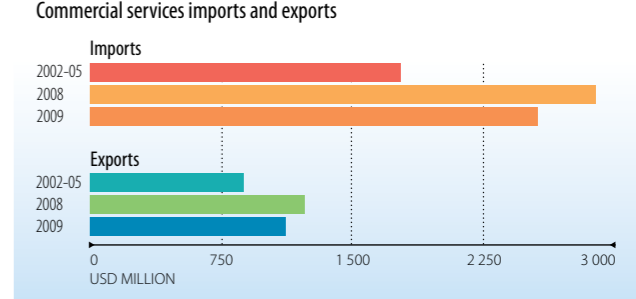
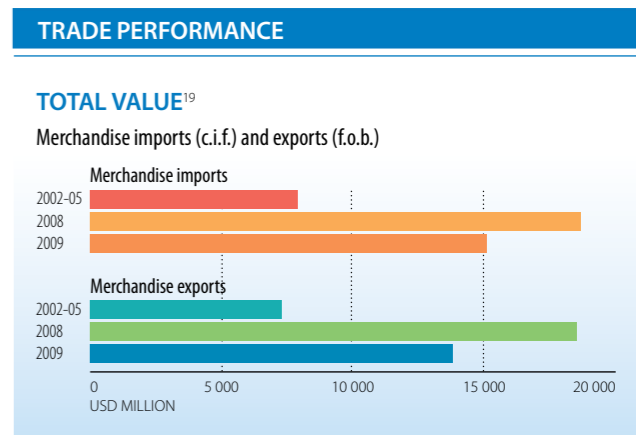
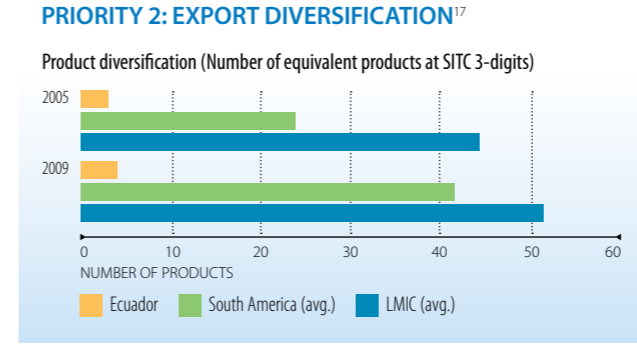
### TRADE MAINSTREAMING<sup>14</sup>

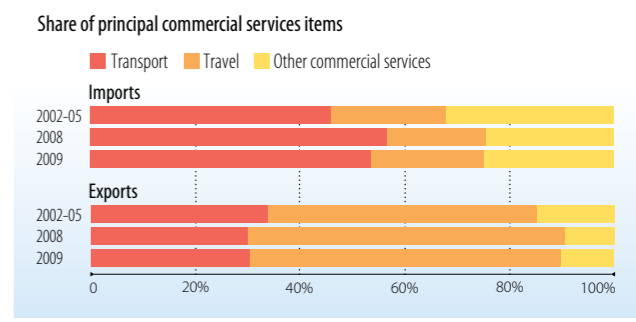
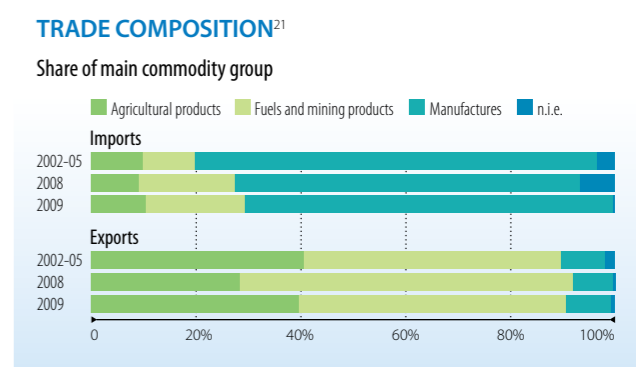

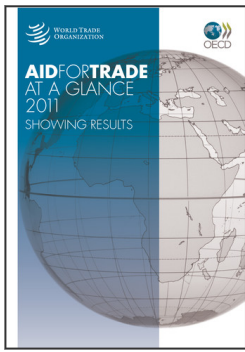
