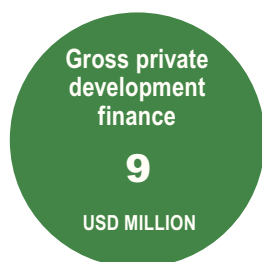

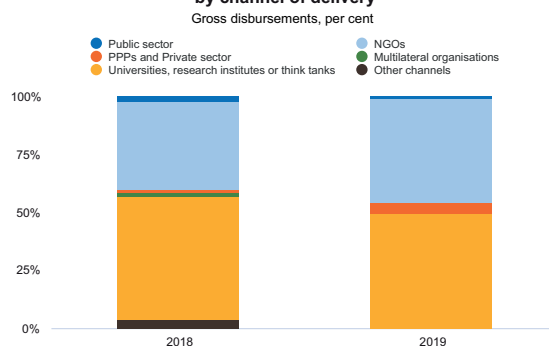

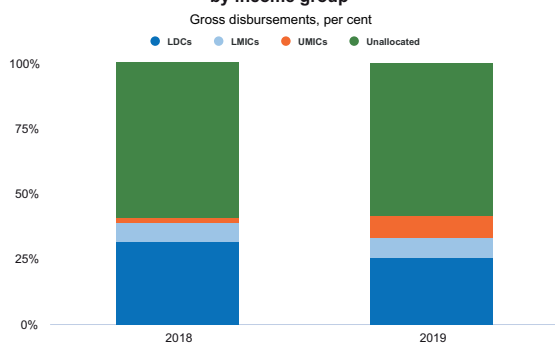

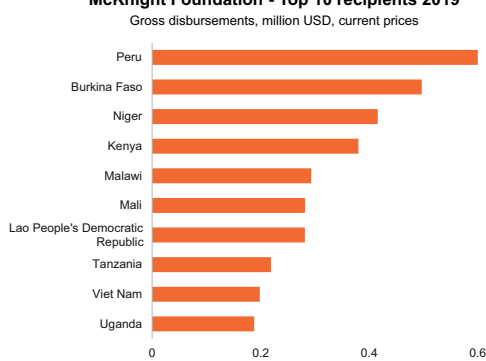
McKnight Foundation - Bilateral private development finance by channel of delivery
